

Road Safety for Farm Machinery

Consider the following to avoid traffic collisions.



PASSING

Pull over to allow farm equipment operators and motorists to pass you. Do not wave drivers on when you think they are safe to pass your equipment.



REQUIRED SIGNAGE

Remember to attach a Slow-Moving Vehicle sign on the rear of your machinery. This will warn other farm equipment operators and motorists that you are travelling slower than the normal speed of traffic.



CAUTION ON GRAVEL ROADS

When moving machinery over to the side of a gravel road, be aware that a soft shoulder can give way and cause a rollover.



TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS

High-visibility clothing is required to protect farm workers managing traffic control. Reflective clothing will ensure they can be seen by farm equipment operators and motorists.

LIGHTING REQUIREMENTS



Use four-way flashers when driving on a public road to ensure farm equipment operators and motorists can see you.

TURNING



When turning, it is recommended to turn off your four-way flashers and briefly pause before signaling to turn. This will alert others of your intention to turn.
